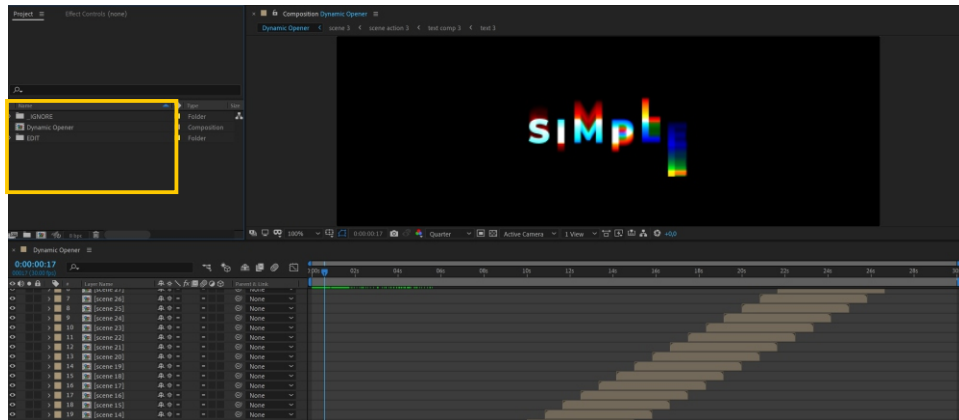
You can change text, videos, colors and logo

Opener customization

First of all, open [Dynamic Opener.aep](#) file.

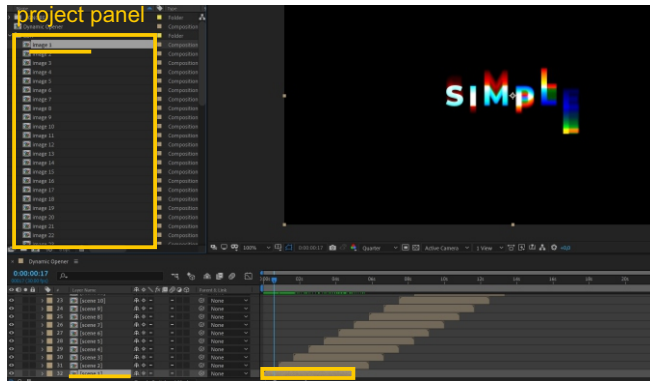
You must have Adobe After Effects CC installed.

In the left [Project panel](#) find [Dynamic Opener](#) comp and double click on it.



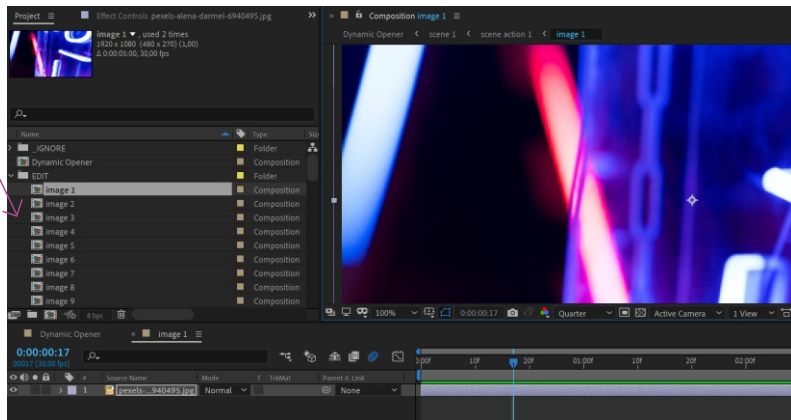
Opener customization

In the opened composition look at the layers in the bottom left corner. To add your images/videos and change the text open **edit** folder in the **Project Panel**. Then find the composition with corresponding number in the name. For example **image 1** comp for **Scene 1** layer. It is easy.



Opener customization

To add your video or photo open one of the 'image' compositions.
For example **image 1**. Import your video/images and just drag and drop it to the opened composition.

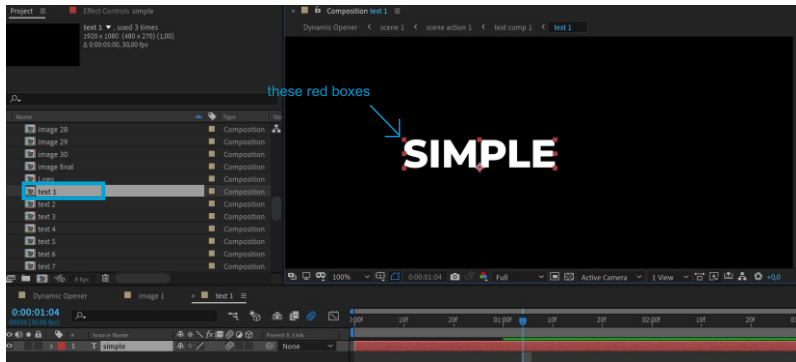


To import media in AfterEffects just double click on the empty space in the Project Panel

Opener customization

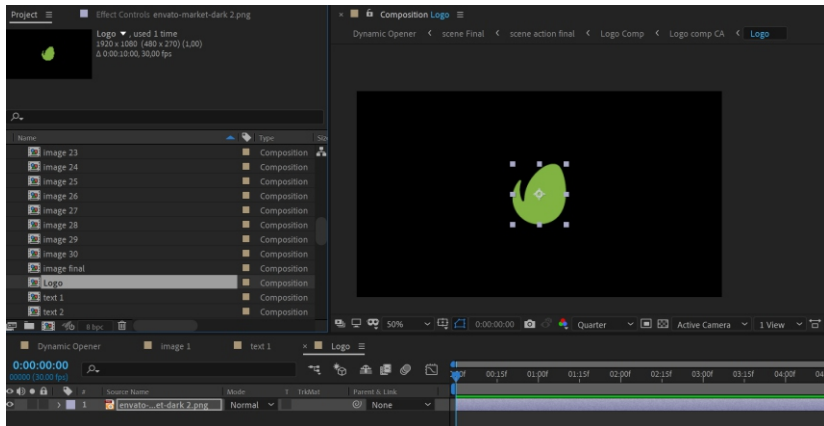
To change the text open one of the 'text' compositions.
For example **text 1**. Just select text layer
and double click on it to type something.

*To change the size of the text use red colored boxes. Holding SHIFT click and drag your mouse.
If you want to add additional text layers select text layer and press CTRL+D*



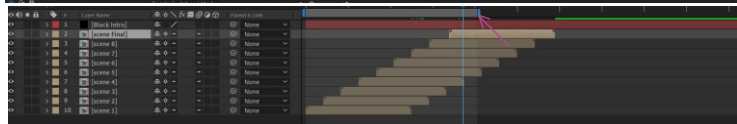
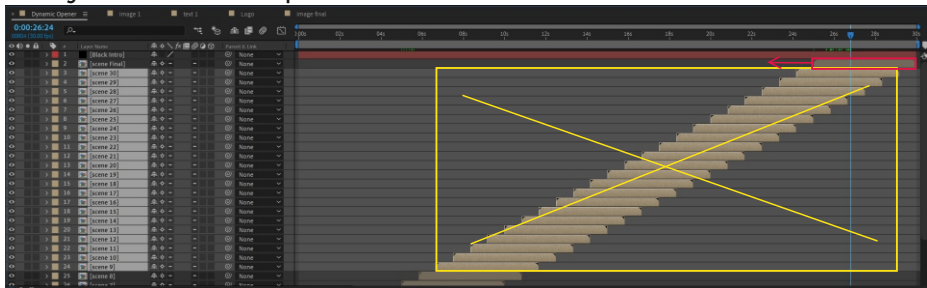
Opener customization

To add your logo go to **Project Panel** and open **EDIT/Logo** comp.
Import your logo with alpha channel and just drag and drop it
to the opened composition.



Opener customization

If you want to get opener with fewer scenes in the **Dynamic Opener** select and delete unnecessary layers (for example scenes #09-30). Then select **Scene Final** and move it left as in the picture below. Add your music and press **CTRL+M** to render.



Remember to move the Work Area End so that the length matches and there is no black screen at the end of the video.
